Dinner Money & Trip Money

Please can all money being sent into school be put in an envelope clearly marked with the following information:

Resurfacing the Community Car Park

The school has been advised that the re-scheduled date for the resurfacing of the community car park at the school is Monday 12th October 2009. During the first two weeks remedial works including the fitting of extra drains will take place, with the resurfacing taking place during half term. During this time parking on site will be severely restricted, therefore we ask that parents/visitors to the school, where possible find alternative parking. Parking off site will alleviate unnecessary congestion and therefore ensure the safety of children and visitors using the site.

During this time **ALL** recycling bins will be removed, could we ask that your recycling be disposed of at the other recycling centres around the village. The bins will return as soon as the work is completed, which we hope will be straight after half term.

Facebook

We have become aware that some older pupils in the school are using Facebook, and are trying to contact adults who work at this school. We would like remind parents and carers that it is a stipulation of the Facebook Registration process that it should not be used by children younger than 13 (Registration and Account Security, section 4).
